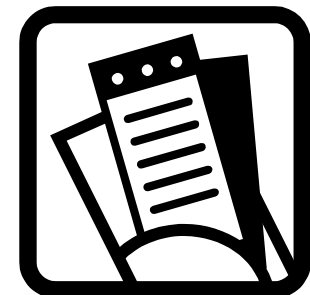

How does the Museum Pass Program work?

The Cliffside Park Library has family membership passes to the museums listed in this brochure. The passes allow Cliffside Park families to visit the museums with free admission. Passes vary on number of free adult & child entries. Offerings subject to change; our website has the most up-to-date information.

Passes are reserved on a first come, first served basis through our online reservation system accessible on our homepage.

To reserve a pass, click on the Museum Pass Program link on our website @ www.cliffsidepark.bccls.org and choose your desired date and pass.

Passes can be reserved up to 60 days in advance. Visit the individual museum's website for operating hours and directions.

On the day of your reservation, visit the library to pick up the pass. You must bring your Cliffside Park Library Card and a **\$40 cash deposit**. ******If the pass is not returned on time, you forfeit your deposit.*** If you cannot return it on time, please make every effort to contact us.

The pass is loaned for **3 days** and must be returned one hour prior to the library's closing on the day the pass is to be returned.

This program is for Cliffside Park Library Card holders only, in good standing. You must be at least 18 to reserve a pass.
